WHEN IN-PERSON LEARNING IS TAKING PLACE

Remote learners may pick up meals **DAILY** at **Fairmount Elementary's front entrance from 10:00-10:30 a.m.** when in-person learning resumes. This will be a drive-thru concept. A breakfast and lunch will be given to each student based upon meal status.

Additional Information

- The emergency meal plan provided to children from March-May is no longer in place. The district has requested that the USDA allow us to provide meals free of charge to all children during this uncertain time. To date, this request has not been granted.
- Each Tuesday, students will receive 2 breakfasts and 2 lunches. Each Thursday, students will receive 3 breakfasts and 3 lunches. Each student can only receive one set of meals per distribution. If any duplicate meals are received at different locations, the meals will be charged to the student's meal account. Parents/guardians are responsible for all meal charges. Meals will be cold items that can be heated when convenient or ready to eat.
- Cost of the meals distributed will be based upon the student's meal status of free, reduced, or paid. Students who ended the 2019-2020 school year with a free or reduced meal status will receive the same temporary status until September 22, 2020. A new application will need to be filled out and returned by that date in order to reapply.
- Meals will be added to a student's meal account. No payments to accounts will be accepted on site. Parents will need to use MySchoolBucks to add money to a child's account. Details about MySchoolBucks can be found at www.btcs.org. Students who are new to BTCS can call the School Nutrition office at (423) 652-9222 to received the required pin number that will be used to set up a new MySchoolBucks account.
- There will be no home delivery of meals.
- Students will be receiving a free and reduced meal application. Upon completion, those forms may be returned to your child's school, a meal distribution site, the administration building, or mailed to Department of School Nutrition, 615 Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., Bristol, TN 37620.
- All students receiving a meal must be enrolled in Bristol Tennessee City Schools.
